Job Goals:	To provide instructional services within a multi-disciplinary framework which goes beyond those normally provided for students identified with superior cognitive ability and/or specific academic ability.

To provide instruction for developing skills in higher level thinking (critical thinking, divergent thinking, logical reasoning, creative problem-solving), research methods, social/emotional skills, and oral/written expression; 2. To provide services that may include advancement in a specific academic discipline, investigation of aesthetic appreciation, career investigation, independent study, and guidance; 3. To know, understand and apply Ohio's Learning Standards to gifted instruction; 4. To provide appropriate instructional leadership for gifted services; 5. To participate on identification committees for the purpose of placement, evaluation, and reassignment of children; 6. To provide communication, evaluation, and reporting of student progress to parents; 7. To consult and collaborate with classroom teachers, school administrators, and community members; 8. To participate in the personal evaluation process with the gifted director and building administrators; 9. To provide records that are appropriate for reporting gifted services; 10. To follow the policy of the school district of attendance regarding the administering of medication; 11. To attend professional workshops and/or conferences pertaining to gifted education; 12. Such other duties as may be assigned by the Director of Gifted Services and/or Superintendent.
