

CRISIS PREVENTION TRAINING PROGRAM



WHY?

The *Nonviolent Crisis Intervention*® program is a safe, nonharmful behavior management system designed to help human service professionals provide for the best possible *Care, Welfare, Safety, and Security*SM of disruptive, assaultive, and out-of-control individuals—even during their most violent moments.

WHERE?

Training on-site or on the campus of the Allen County Educational Service Center will be provided. Participants should dress comfortably with loose clothing and soft-soled shoes.

Space required to host training should include an area equipped to set up a PowerPoint presentation with table and chairs for participants, as well as a cleared space to safely teach the physical intervention techniques.

WHEN?

The ACESC will sponsor several initial and refresher trainings throughout the school year.
